



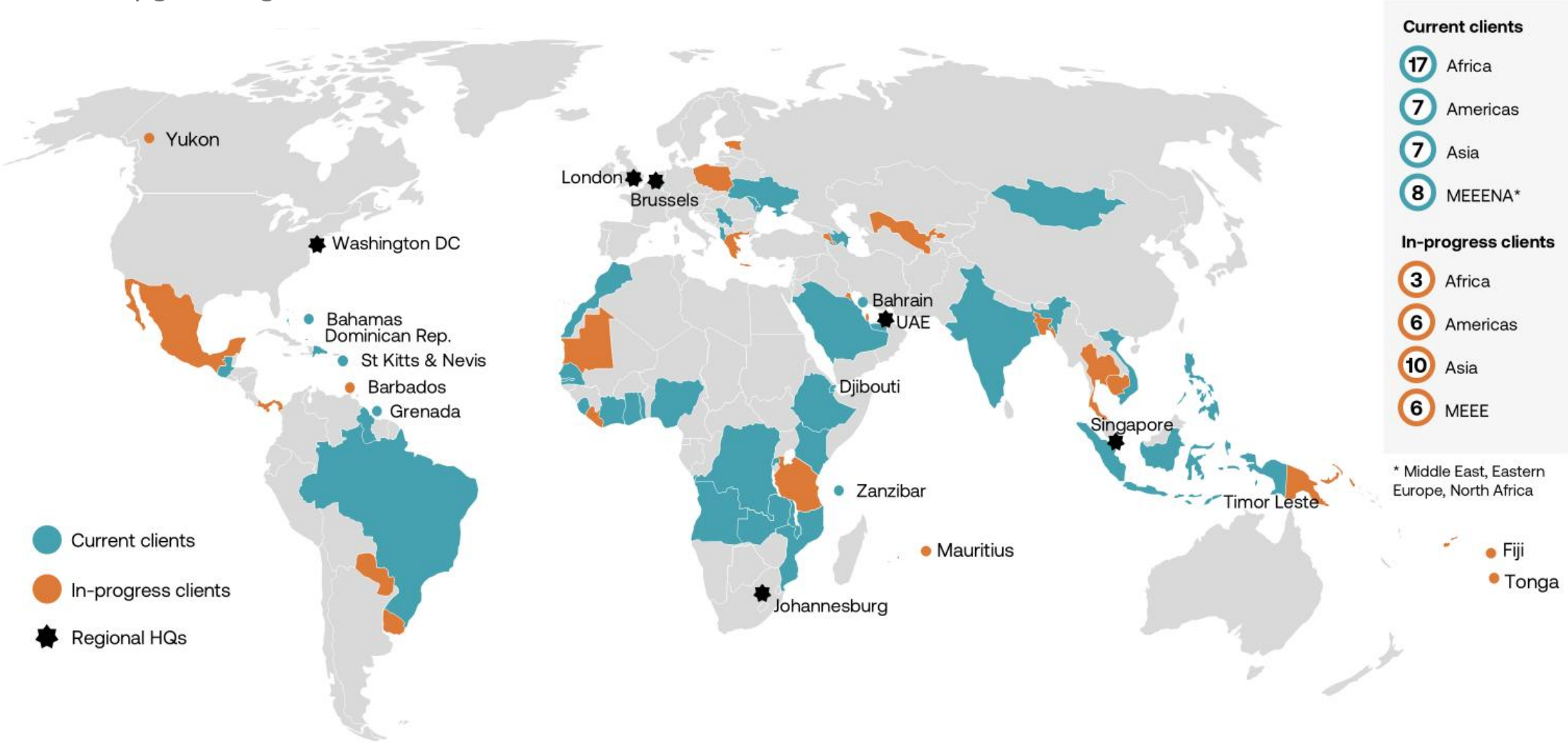

The greatest opportunity for governments today is the technological revolution. Across all our work, we help leaders unlock the power of technology to create real change for their people.

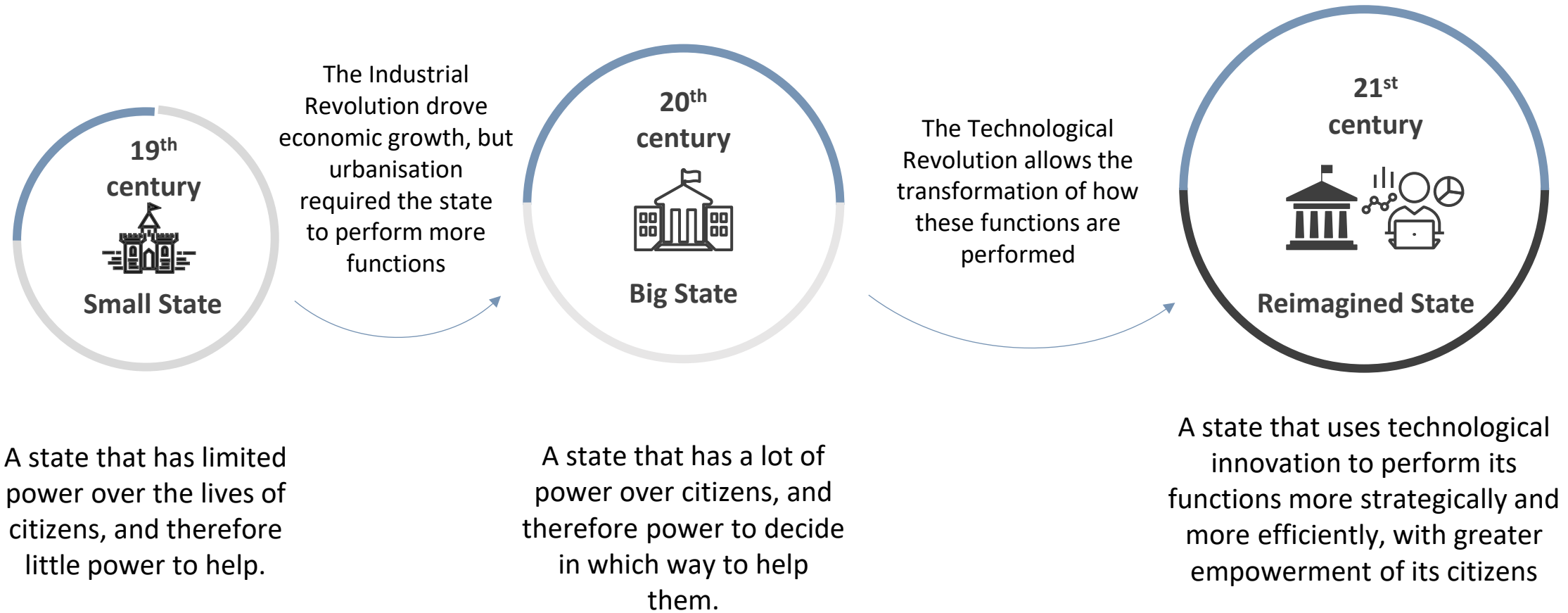
- ✓ We work with **senior political leaders** at national or sub-national level (“N, N-1, N-2”)

National Digital Health Strategy



TBI has led the end-to-end development of national digital health strategies in the Americas, Africa, Eastern Europe, and Asia-Pacific.

Digital Health Laws & Legislation



TBI supported governments in Africa and Eastern Europe to develop and enact legislation to enable digital health (e.g., electronic documentation, health governance, data governance)

Health Services Delivery



TBI supported an Asian government develop a strategy to strengthen health services delivery in primary care, with a strong focus on early disease detection, focused preventative care, and optimal capacity allocation.

Health Analytics and Innovation



TBI designed the operating model for a national health analytics and innovation unit within Eastern Europe and supported an East African country in the deployment of data analytics for key disease priorities.

Tertiary Care



TBI supported a Caribbean nation's PM make progress on his commitment to build a new tertiary care hospital and supported the coordination of an EMR for a national referral hospital in Africa.

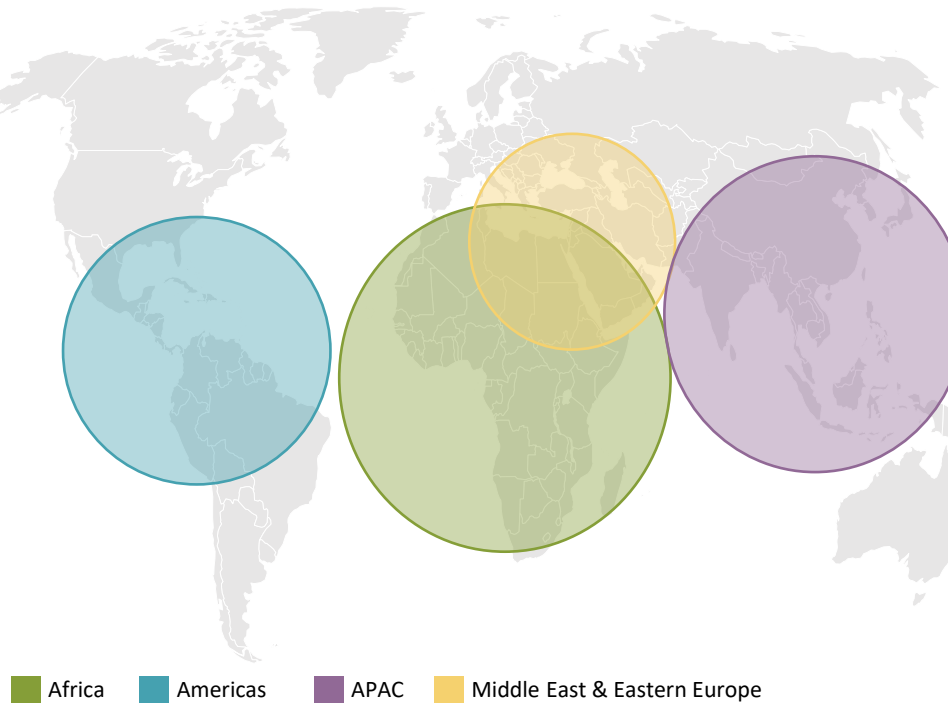


TBI supported a government's efforts to fill in the doctors' vacancies through undertaking global benchmarking.


Tech for Access to Care
